The meeting was opened with Salute to the Flag led by Supervisor Todd Bradt.

Supervisor Bradt welcomed Andrew Duesler and Douglas Chambers from the Johnstown High School P.I.G.S. Class

Andy Chorlton made a motion to accept the minutes from March 14, 2012 Regular meeting. 2nd by George Cosselman. 5 Ayes. Carried.

Ivan Duesler made a motion to pay General bills, Abstract 4, Claim # 55 thru 65 for the amount of \$ 5,553.64. 2nd by George Cosselman. 5 Ayes. Carried.

Thomas Miles made a motion to pay Highway bills, Abstract 4, Claim # 55 thru 75 for the amount of \$ 7,134.87. 2nd by Ivan Duesler. 5 Ayes. Carried.

Communication: The Dept. of Agriculture & Markets conducted two inspections:

- 1. Municipal Shelter Inspection
- 2. Dog Control Officer Inspection (Daniel Robinson, DCO)

Both inspections reported to be "Satisfactory".

Supervisor Bradt has a copy of the C.G. Roxane Bottling Plant plans for Johnstown and also a copy of the Highway study that was sent in for Ephratah.

Public Input: Joseph Dickenson provided the Board with handouts regarding cell phones and microwave cell towers. He also asked the Board to enact a town law not to accept the microwave cell tower in the town.

Reports:

<u>Code Enforcement Officer:</u> A report was submitted for review.

- 1 Certificate of Occupancy Issued
- 5 Violation Notices Issued

David Rackmyre, Jr has now received the plans for the microwave cell tower. If approved for the Tower to be erected, a variance would need to be granted, as the lot size is smaller than local law allows. They want 100' X 100' lot, tower to be 170' high.

The pending court case for violation has been adjourned by the Attorneys and no new date set.

<u>Planning Board:</u> The proposed Dominion microwave cell tower was the topic of discussion. Joe Dickenson and Jack Keppler asked for a moratorium on the cell tower project until more studies can be done on the possible side-effects. Three representatives from Dominion were present and asked to return for the next Planning Board Meeting.

The Planning Board members will participate in the Fulton County Clean-up Day on May 5, 2012.

<u>Highway Superintendent:</u> Working on the grade-all; the flag pole needs to be replaced. Jim said he can purchase a pole for approximately \$450. The crew is working on the roads to be black-topped, getting them ready. Jim also asked the Board for permission to clean the scrap steel from the "back-yard".

Resolution 53

George Cosselman offered Resolution 53 authorizing Jim Berry, Hwy Superintendent, permission to clean and sell the scrap steel in the back yard. The monies received goes to the Town. 2nd by Thomas Miles. 5 Ayes. Carried.

Resolution 54

George Cosselman offered Resolution 54 authorizing Jim Berry permission to purchase and replace the Flag Pole at the Town Hall site for approximately \$450. 2nd by Ivan Duesler. 5 Ayes. Carried.

Jim reported the mining pit will open May 1, 2012, therefore an inspection of the pit will probably take place.

<u>Youth:</u> The Easter Party was a great success, with a large turn-out; approximately 65 - 80 kids. April 21^{st} softball sign-up and bottle drive will take place. There will also be a sign-up in May. The floor of the Recreation building will get pressure washed and then sealed.
