Amendment to Ephratah Town Code Sections 80-13 and 80-14.

Local Law Number 1 of 2014

Section 80-13. Establishment of schedule. Shall be amended as follows:

There shall be no fees in conjunction with the Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Construction Code, and in accordance with Article I, Section 80-5 of the Ephratah Town Code as follows.

Inspection Type

New construction and additions (living/business areas, excluding garages)

Modular homes (including mobile homes)
First unit
Additional units
1 to 3
More than 3

Garages

New chimneys
Without solid fuel devices
With solid fuel devices

In-ground pools (electrical inspection is also required separately)

Porch

Section 80-14. Renewals. Shall be amended as follows:

For the renewal of any permit over one (1) year old, no fee is required. Permits may only be renewed for one (1) additional year. Any work not finished within two (2) years will require a new application and the payment of the then applicable fees.
