Assessor:

- The Assessor's office has been collecting data for the 2026 Tentative Roll.
- It is that time of the year to apply for any senior or agricultural exemptions. Renewal forms will be going out in the mail in the fall and due back no later than March 1st, 2026. Anyone applying for a new 10 year agricultural building exemption is also due March 1st.

- Anyone planning on applying for any new star exemptions or changing from the basic star to the enhanced will need to apply with the state. There are new regulations coming out. Ms. Yuenger has no other information available at this time but is planning on having a link on the town website when it is. They will be sending letters to Basic STAR recipients who we know will be turning 65 as of December 31, 2025.
- As of January, 2026, we will be sending a letter to new property buyers about all available exemptions and the requirements for each along with a property inventory questionnaire to help identify any property data that needs to be updated or reviewed.
